1.0 BACKGROUND

1.1 Christ Orphanage Home

Christ Orphanage Home Ondo is a faith based Non Governmental Organisation with focus on caring for abandoned babies, orphans and motherless children. We work with various institutions including government establishments, private organisations, groups of interested people as well as individuals that are positively inclined towards the realization of the Orphanage's goal.

The Home is duly registered and approved by both the Nigerian Corporate Affairs Commission Abuja and also by the Ondo State Government as a qualified organisation to carry out orphanage and other non profit related activities within Nigeria

1.1.1 How it all began...

Christ Orphanage Home Ondo was founded by my humble self; Evang. (Mrs.) Solayide Anike Olaseinde in response to the call of God to care for the abandoned babies, orphans and motherless babies. On 9th November, 1993, God called me to work for Him in His Vineyard. Then I formed the Busy and Young Bees Societies, but resisted full time work in His Vineyard, because my business was then booming in Oke-Arin market in Lagos Island. I, however, noticed that all the profit I was making from the business was being siphoned by satan through various problems.

I decided to give up my business on the 17th December, 2000 to make time for God's work. I then enrolled at deliverance and Healing Unit School of St. Barth's Anglican Church, Aguda for 18 months Course and also at Lagos Bible College at Board Street under the management of the Anglican Communion for all the Courses up to Readers Course. God called me again on 28th may, 2001 to start counselling in His house at St. Luke's Anglican Church, Ijeshatedo, Lagos. It was in the course of carrying out my work as a counsellor in the House of God that I came across an old lady who lost her daughter. The late daughter left behind six children and her husband, but the father of the six children had abandoned them, leaving the old lady to take care of them.

Naturally, I was moved to sympathy with the plight of this family. Unfortunately, I had no means to be of assistance to them. I cried to God in prayers and fasting at the

end of which God directed me to take care of two of her six children. The kids, a boy and a girl of ages 5 and 4 respectively got to me on October, 2001. The eldest was taken by a friend of the family. I have solicited for help from the people of God to take care of the remaining three kids but no help came. There is no doubt that there are several other families in similar or worse situation either in the church as to what to do to be useful in His Vineyard.

It was the burden I had for the remaining three kids, one boy and two girls that made God to call me to form Christ Motherless Babies' Home under the supervision of my local church, St. Luke's Anglican Church, Ijeshatedo, Lagos. The name Christ Motherless Babies' Home was changed to Christ Orphanage because of the broader scope of caring for motherless, abandoned babies, orphans and less privileged in the society. It is my joy that this orphanage has grown to a Non Governmental Organization

3.0 OUR ACHIEVEMENTS SO FAR

3.1 HEALTH AND EDUCATION

All our children are well taken care of. They are all in good health, and all are currently schooling. Their Education fees are being paid by promptly by the Grace of God and the help of our sponsors/ and helpers. They also have lesson teachers teaching them at our home after school.

Christ Orphanage Home Ondo also assist some children yearly with N10,000.00 for their tuition and books. So far 25 children have benefited and by the grace of God, this number increases yearly.

3.2 FOOD SUPPLIES AND OTHER DONATIONS

We are able to provide good food on the table for our children. This has been done by our corporate effort together with our sponsors. Cash and Food items donated are managed judiciously in feeding of our children and taking proper care of them even better than what could be achieved when in their individual parent's houses.

3.3. ACCOMMODATION/SLEEPING QUARTERS

Good accommodation have been provided for our children in our rented facility at No 48, Okebola Street Ondo such that all our children sleep individually on bunks in a well ventilated sleeping room free from mosquitoes and other pests. these facilities

wwere rented and currently Christ Orphange home is building her permanent site at Pele Area, Ondo which is still under construction.

3.4 EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

One of our core activities at Christ Orphanage Home Ondo is the empowerment of women in order to effectively and adequately provide for their children and entire family, thereby reducing the poverty among women and increasing their level of productivity and contributing to national development.

Brief History of the Yearly Empowerment Programme

The empowerment programme began as a result of a pledge I made to God the Most High that I'll empower ten (10) women if He let my daughter's wedding succeed. To the greatest glory of His name, it was a huge success. So I commenced the programme between 28th and 30th January, 2010. In this programme ten women and a man were empowered namely;

Alice Olubusade. Since then till now, lots of people have been blessed by God through this programme.

From then till now over 60 men and women have passed through from year 2000 till date.

5.0 CONCLUSION

Christ Orphanage Home Ondo, is an NGO established on 28th November, 2001 with the aim of caring for abandoned babies, orphans, motherless children and to empower widows and other less privileged women in the society. For Seventeen (17) years, the foundation has supported over fifty (50) abandoned babies and one (1) undergraduate, supported over fifty eight (58) less privileged women through its various skill acquisition programs and offer financial support for micro enterprises. These are significant achievements especially since we seldom receive support and donations from God sent individuals. Presently, we shelter and cater for the feeding, medical and educational needs of nine (9) children between the ages of one (1) and twenty five (25) years. Our present population has outgrown our rented accommodation hence we are in dare need of a permanent shelter. The cost of the on-going building project has been estimated at Sixty Million Naira (₹60,000,000.00) and we are counting on your generosity to make this dream a reality.
